# RESOLUTION REGARDING LYNX NETWORK GROUP RIGHT-OF-WAY TELECOMMUNICATIONS PERMIT

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Metropolitan Extension Telecommunications Rights-of-Way Oversight Act, Act No. 48 of the Public Acts of 2002, the Charter Township of Monitor did adopt Ordinance No. 51 providing for the permitting of Telecommunications providers utilizing rights-of-way within the Township; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2015, Merit Network Inc., did submit a

Telecommunications Permit Application with exhibits,

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, the Township of Monitor does hereby approve the Telecommunications Permit Application of Lynx Network Group, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Clerk of the Township is hereby instructed to issue a bilateral permit to the Applicant for an Initial effective Period of fifteen (15) years, and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Township is hereby further directed to notify the Michigan Public Service Commission of the approval of this permit.

### **REPORTS**

Brandt reported the Road Commission is planning to replace the Culvert Creek bridge on Midland Rd. (between Fraser & 7 Mile) as well as renovating the 7 Mile Rd. bridge at the Kawkawlin River. Construction for the Culvert Creek bridge is expected May 31, 2016 ó September 31, 2016. The Road Commission stated they will not work on both bridges during the same time period to reduce the impact on traffic.

Brandt was also advised the Road Commission may not offer the \$20,000 Building Better Roads match this year.

Brandt reported the floor tile in the front lobby are badly worn & cracked. He received one estimate for new tile in the amount of \$4,000 (not including labor). Board members advised getting additional estimates and would like the tile professionally installed.
