SPECIAL TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 2:06 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to give the opportunity for The Sidock Group to present the fire station facilities assessment report to township board. The assessment detailed areas in which the fire station no longer meets the current standards for vehicle exhaust, ventilation, and space between vehicles just to name a few. There are also mechanical and electrical components that no longer meet code.

Sidock compiled estimates to renovate and expand the existing station as well as the cost to build a new station off site. The comparison showed it was financially more cost effective to remain at the current location. This was also affirmed by the fire station fact-finding committee.

The board will set additional meetings to discuss the concept renovation/expansion plan, possible modifications to the plan as well as financing options.
