The lobby has a recycle bin for Holiday lights and A Toys for tots drop off box. The next blood drive is Dec.30<sup>th</sup>. The Bay Co. Road Commission put signage near McAlear Sawden school which lowers the speed limit during drop off and pickup times, a flashing sign would be a good addition too. The road patrol is enforcing this new speed limit.
